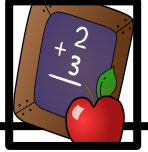

MATH

***Place Value** - This week we will work on adding and subtracting whole numbers up to one million (with and without regrouping). We will be working on regrouping (carrying & borrowing).

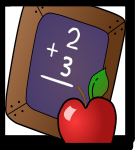
